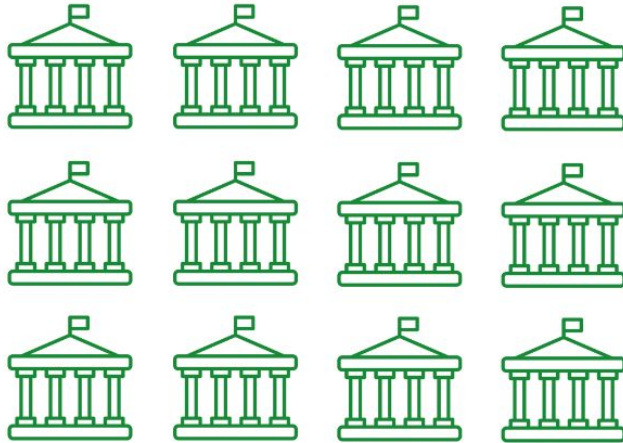

# Securing Our First Contract

## Pass legislation

In 2021, AFSCME helps pass SB9/HB486, unifying the collective bargaining process across the University System of Maryland.

## Choose priorities

In Fall 2022, a survey is sent to all AFSCME bargaining unit members asking about their top priorities and issues at work and what solutions they want to see negotiated into a contract.

## Form bargaining team

AFSCME higher education bargaining team formed in fall 2022 and virtual kick-off is held.

With the strength of our union behind them, the bargaining team fights for the improvements members want.

## Negotiate

From 2022 until now, the AFSCME bargaining team has been meeting regularly with USM leadership to negotiate the first unified contract for the USM.

## Vote on contract!

**Once a tentative agreement has been reached, bargaining unit staff must vote "Yes" or "No" on whether to ratify the contract.**

If the majority of those voting vote "Yes" on the contract, it is ratified and immediately put into effect.

## What about other topics, like telework?

The following topics that will be negotiated on an **institutional level** include the following:

- Designation of essential employees
- Student breaks and holidays
- Hours of work
- Other compensation that does not directly impact wages or salary
- Shift differentials
- Teleworking
- Uniforms and equipment

## **Your Union Rights (Per Your Union Contract)**

*Each employee shall have **the right to join, discuss, access, communicate with, seek aid from, and assist their exclusive representative without fear of penalty or reprisal** and shall also have the right to refrain from such actions.*

*No employees shall be discriminated against based upon their union activities or affiliation, or lack thereof.*
