





2022 Bargaining Survey Results

- Wages are the top issue, followed by promotions/job ladder, telework, and health and safety.
- Respondents noted many health and safety concerns, ranging from COVID to mold.
- When it comes to leave, increasing leave and creating a leave bank were the most important.
- Over 75% of respondents agreed that the former merit system was unfair.
 Respondents were pretty split between favoring flat increases, percentage increases or unsure.

What about telework?

Telework will be bargained at an institution-level. It is required by law for each institution to negotiate a telework policy.

Over 65% of respondents said telework is very important to them.

No employees shall be discriminated against based upon their union activities or affiliation, or lack thereof.


